Dear Parents/Carers

1st December 2021

We are delighted that this year our infant children will be able to perform a live nativity play that you are all able to come and see. However, due to the number of very specific and detailed risk assessments that I have received today and that I must satisfy in order that the nativity can be performed in church I have had to make the very difficult decision to hold the performance in school rather than in the church this year.

As a result of this we will now be holding the school nativity at 2pm on Friday 10th December and then again at 3pm on Friday 10th December. As said, both productions will be in the school hall. Parents/carers will come into the school via the old entrance on Whalley Road and be allowed into school 10 minutes before the performance, please come into school and be seated as soon as possible without walking around and socialising. As soon as the performance has finished you will be asked to sanitise your seat and leave school through the reception exiting onto Clitheroe Road. Your child will not be able to leave school with you after the 2pm performance but can after the 3pm performance.

Nursery and Mrs Jackson's class (including the Year 1 children) are invited to attend the 2pm performance.

Miss Thompson's Class (the remaining Year 1 children and Year 2) are invited to attend the 3pm performance.

You will be asked to wear a face covering/mask whilst in the school hall and use hand sanitiser on entry. We will ventilate the hall as much as possible so advise you to wrap up warm. Please do not bring anybody who has not been allocated a ticket as they will be turned away and we also ask if you can keep younger siblings at home with carers if at all possible. For young children who do attend they must sit on a parent's lap or one of the two chairs allocated. Please note there will be NO TOILET facilities available.

I know that some of these measures might sound a little extreme, but we are doing our best to ensure that your child's live nativity can go ahead and that you are able to come and see it.
