PERFORMANCE 2021 - 2022

PUPIL PROGRESS (STATUTORY)

EYFS (10 pupils, each pupil is 10%):

- 100% of Pupils reached GLD for all Prime Areas (PSED, Physical Development, Communication & Language) compared to 65.3% nationally and 62.3% in Lancashire.
- 90% of pupils reached GLD for Literacy and Mathematics compared to 65.3% nationally and 62.2% in Lancashire.

Year 1 Phonics Screen (10 children, each pupil is 10%)::

- 80% of pupils reached the pass threshold for Phonics, compared to 75% nationally and 74% in Lancashire.
- 90% reached a score of 37/40 or higher with 40% reaching a full score

Year 2 Phonics re-take (3 pupils, each pupil is 33.3%)

- 100% (3) of Y2 pupils reached the pass threshold for Phonics (Y2) compared to 44% nationally and 40.9 in Lancashire.

KS1 SATs - Year 2 (14 children, each pupil is 7.1%):

- 86% of pupils reached Expected Standard (EXS) in Reading compared to 67%* nationally. And 63.9% in Lancashire.
- 86% of pupils reached Expected Standard (EXS) in Writing compared to 58%* nationally and 54.9 in Lancashire.
- 80% of pupils reached Expected Standard (EXS) in GPS.
- 86% of pupils reached Expected Standard (EXS) in Mathematics compared to 68%* nationally and 65% in Lancashire.

KS2 SATs (10 pupils*, each pupil is 10%):

(*4 pupils started at Sabden end of Y5/beginning of Y6)

- GPS – 90% of pupils reached Expected Standard (EXS) in Writing compared to 72% nationally. And 71.8 in Lancashire.
- Reading – 70% of pupils reached Expected Standard (EXS) in Writing compared to 74% nationally and 74% in Lancashire.
- Writing – 80% of pupils reached Expected Standard (EXS) in Writing compared to 70% nationally and 68% in Lancashire.
- Maths - 60% of pupils reached Expected Standard (EXS) in Writing compared to 71% nationally and 72% in Lancashire.
