## General Housekeeping

Breakfast Club—you must book in advance for this service. We cannot accept drop ins. Forms for term starting September 2022 are available at the office or on the website—please complete and return before 4th July 2022.

Administrations of medicines in school—please note where at all possible parents needs to administer medication before or after school. If your child requires prescribed medication during the school day, please contact the office who will advise you of the procedure.

Parking—Yet again we have had complaints from local residents expressing serious concern for pedestrian and child safety caused by the way some of our parents are parking at drop off and collection times. We seem to have to regularly remind parents in this respect. PLEASE show consideration to the local community, pedestrians and other road users by not parking on the flats carpark next to school, blocking entrances to driveways and streets or obstructing junctions, please park your car in a safe manner. Thank you.

School meals will be increasing in September 2022 from £2.35 to £2.40. Remember if your child is moving from Year 2 to Year 3, your child is no longer entitled to Universal Free School Meals and will be charged for school meals taken.

Also remember to inform the office before the holidays if you wish to change your school meal options. This must be emailed to the office on office@sabden.lancs.sch.uk. School meal patterns can be changed at the end of each half term for the next term ahead.

Please ensure that payments are made timely—we cannot allow arrears to accrue.

ParentPay—please can you ensure your accounts are paid by 15th July to allow end of year procedures.
